Applicants must hold a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or greater for consideration.

Please submit the following along with your application to rrwc.communityscholarships@gmail.com: When submitting please, resave the PDF application file and rename with your full name, or scan a completed copy.

- A typed statement by the applicant (500 words or less) explaining the impact of community service in their high school years. Grammar and spelling will be considered.
- A complete resume including activities, volunteer work, employment, and honors/awards. Special attention will be paid to a sustained commitment to service. We will consider the COVID pandemic and impact on in-person service in addition to ways you have adapted to serving your community.
- An unofficial transcript along with a letter of acceptance from a post-secondary institution.
- Finalists will be asked to participate in a 15-minute video or telephone conference with the Scholarship Comittee. If you require alternate means of communication or the use of an interpreter, please communicate that information when selected as a finalist and accommodations will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
